Currency/banking

The currency used in Malaysia is the Malaysia Ringgit (MYR), and in the Malay language, also known as Ringgit Malaysia (RM). For example, USD1 equals RM4.42, and 1 euro equals RM4.79, depending on real-time currency exchange. Please note that although many places in Malaysia accept credit cards, you may want to carry some cash just in case.

Many ATMs in Malaysia accept foreign debit and credit cards. So please activate your overseas spending and withdrawal.

Climate

The average temperature during the day is around 34°C (93°F), and the average low temperature at night is about 25°C (77°F). Humidity levels are high, averaging 65-70%, making it feel even hotter.

Power

The standard electrical voltage in Malaysia is 240 volts AC, 50Hz. The electrical outlets in Malaysia are usually **Type G**. If you travel from a country that uses a different voltage or electrical outlet type, you must bring an appropriate adapter or converter to use your electrical devices in Malaysia.

- The countries marked as (*) are only allowed to enter Malaysia by air.
- Israel citizens** must get approval from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Malaysia.
- A visa is not required for a stay of less than one (1) month for ASEAN nationals except for Myanmar.
- Visas are needed for the duration of stay exceeding (1) month except for Brunei and Singapore nationals.

c. Countries not listed on the box above will get your visa upon arrival.

d. Please print your notification of acceptance from the Oxford Abstract system. You may also print your return ticket in case the immigration officer asks you.

e. Travel documents that require a visa to enter Malaysia are as follows:

1. Laissez Passer
2. Certificate of Identity
3. Titres De Voyages
4. US Re-entry Permit For Naturalization
5. Surat Perjalanan Laksana Passport (SPLP) Indonesia

Filling in the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC)

- a. Visitors must complete a Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC)/(IM.26) upon arrival at any gate of entry gazetted at the URL <https://imigresen-online.imi.gov.my/mdac/main>.
- b. Visitors must present their passports together with a complete MDAC to the Immigration Officer on duty, and visitors must also ensure that their passports or travel documents are validated with the appropriate pass before leaving the immigration counter.

Travel

Transport to and from KLIA/KLIA 2

The approximate cost of an E-Hailing ride from KLIA or KLIA 2 to :

- KLIA / KLIA 2 » Bangi Resort Hotel = MYR 65.00 – MYR 75.00 (35-45 min in light traffic);
- KLIA / KLIA 2 » D' Gateway Perdana Hotel = MYR 55.00 – MYR 65.00 (30-35 min in light traffic);
- KLIA / KLIA 2 » Bangi Gateway Hotel = MYR MYR 55.00 – MYR 65.00 (30-35 min in light traffic);
- KLIA / KLIA 2 » Kolej Ibu Zain = MYR 50.00 – MYR 60.00 (35-40 min in light traffic);

But it can take up to an hour or more during peak hours or heavy traffic. It would help if you only used official E-Hailing to avoid potential scams or overcharging.

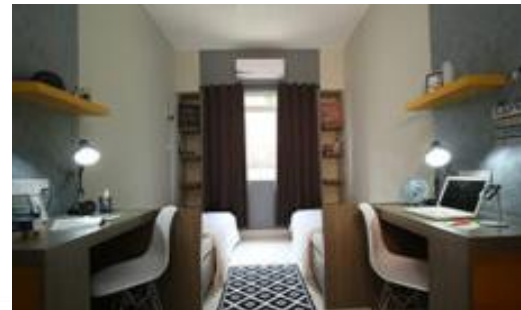
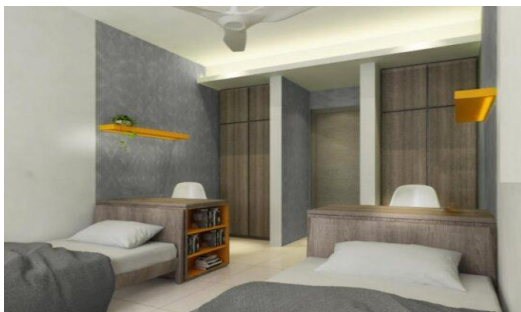

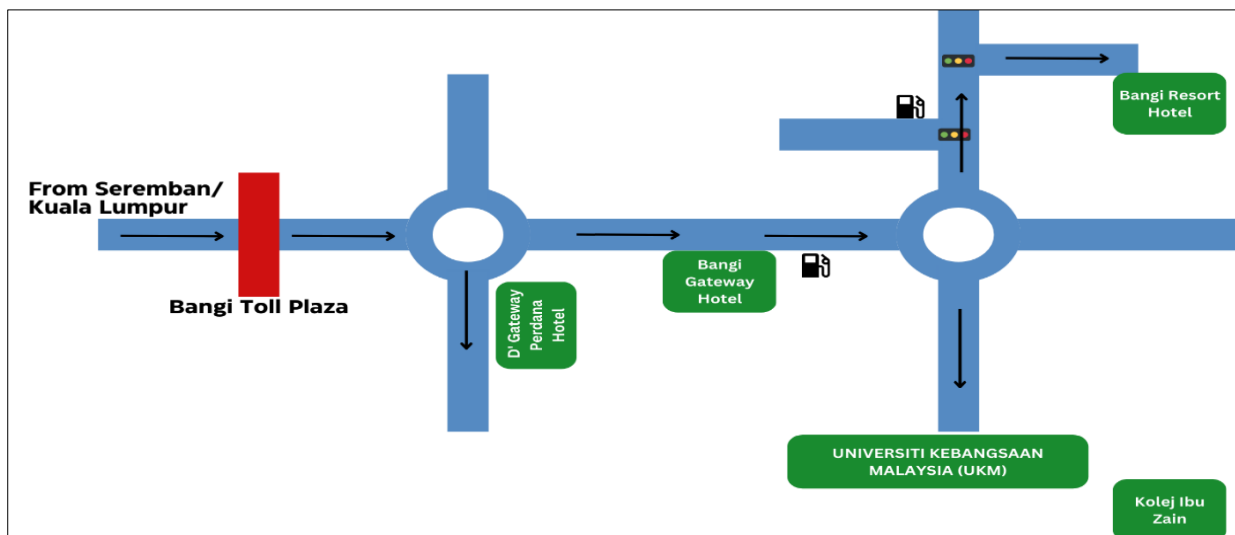
